Lenton Abbey: A new role for me and all of us!

Many of you will know that we have been working closely with a neighbouring parish, St Barnabas Lenton Abbey in seeking to be a resourcing church for them. They are a small congregation and as resources are currently distributed in the Church of England there is no longer a clergy post allocated to the parish. For the past year we have worked together and we have helped resource them with preachers, leaders and communion cover. Both PCC's have welcomed this relationship and I have been invited to become 'Priest-in-Charge' at Lenton Abbey in addition to my duties in Chilwell parish. The diocese for their part commit to support me and one expression of that has been to extend the licence of Lillian Heptinstall at Inham Nook until 2014 to continue good work there and to ensure that there are at least two priests in the parish of Chilwell. Jenny Corcoran during her third year of curacy will give a good part of her time to working at Lenton Abbey. Obviously this new responsibility will involve some extra work load for me but I envisage sharing this with our leadership team.

On Sunday 29th November at 7.00 p.m. there will be a service at Lenton Abbey at which my new additional role will formally begin. The Archdeacon Peter Hill will lead and speak at this service. We will combine our evening service with this event and I would be thrilled if as many of you as possible could come and support me and them. Alan Howe - Vicar
