**WELCOME !!** Thank you for joining us today as we meet to worship our Lord Jesus Christ. We pray that you will feel part of His family here. If you are new please make yourself known to us – there are welcome cards at Christ Church on the table by the door to complete and hand in if you wish. Please do stay with us after the service for refreshments and a chat or if you would value prayer with the prayer ministry team they are always available after the service.

As we write this, we are all recovering from a busy weekend, whether the parish weekend at Swanwick, supporting friends during ordination, or just getting on with our regular activities. We hope that you are feeling refreshed and challenged by the last weekend as we meet together to worship God this morning.

Ordination is the setting aside or consecrating of a person who the community believes has been called to minister in a particular role.

During the ordination service for deacons we are told "Deacons are ordained so that the people of God may be better equipped to make Christ known." So although at the ordination services last week some individuals were set aside to minister, it is the job of every Christian to make Christ known, through the way we live, how we deal with each other and people around us, and by being "salt and light" in the community.

At Pathway, we are coming to the end of a series of talks (available at pathwaychilwell.org.uk) looking at different aspects of prayer and practical ways to pray. We have had seven "First Fridays" - time and space to engage with God in a creative way, and it has been encouraging that we have started to see people from the community join us.
