PLACEMENT

As neither of these ideas sounded very exciting, Dan (my husband – curate at St Helen's, Stapleford) and I are going to be spending our placement looking into new forms of church. We've got the opportunity to interview people who are involved with new forms of church, finding out what they do and have experienced, things that work well and problems that have arisen. We will be spending time travelling around the country, but the first thing we're doing is a week's course at St John's college.

The idea behind new forms of church is the realisation that whilst a parish system, with regular Sunday worship is great for some people, it isn't always the best model for reaching everyone in our rapidly changing and diverse culture. It's not about replacing traditional church, but finding ways to work alongside it, so that everyone has the opportunity to hear how much God loves them. We'd really value your prayers for us that we would be able to make the most of this opportunity.
