WELCOME !! Thank you for joining us today as we meet to worship our Lord Jesus Christ. We pray that you will feel part of His family here. Church Family Weekend

No one will need reminding that this week-end about 200 of us will be attending the week-end away at Swanwick. Some of you reading this will be there, or have been there as day visitors. We pray that you are being richly blessed. But we've also been praying that those who are left behind will share the blessing, that the congregations at home will also have rich time even though perhaps depleted a little in numbers – that our bountiful God will reach down, and touch every single person attached in any way to us in any way with His hand of blessing. We are in faith He will do so.

OUR NEW BISHOP

We've particular reason to rejoice over the appointment of the Right Revd Paul Butler as the new Bishop of Southwell and Nottingham.

Bishop Paul, who is Suffragan Bishop of Southampton, in the Winchester Diocese, graduated at Nottingham University and later worked in the city.

Through this time he was a regular worshipper here at Christ Church and helped with our youth work.

He remembers those days with great fondness as being the time when he first contemplated the possible call to ordained ministry.

He and his wife, Rosemary, will be moving here soon after Christmas at the beginning of this new phase of ministry.

As chairman of the Church Missionary Society Bishop Paul has a world view and is also a strong proponent of work with children, on which he has written an acclaimed book.
