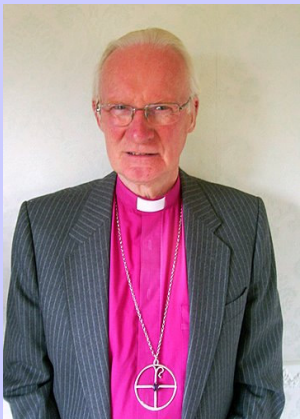
Speaker & Chaplain Profiles
